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About Gardeniser Hub

Gardeniser (garden + organiser) is a continuing education programme that develops organisational, communication and management skills in people who are working or volunteering in city farms and community gardens.

The project of Gardeniser Hub (training the trainer) provides a training course focusing on preparing its trainers to lead and deliver the Gardeniser Pro Training Course. This intellectual output is a partnership organisation based across all sectors of Europe and the UK. The course will be implemented across Europe and the UK in as many countries as possible.

Course Content

You'll learn how to prepare trainers to lead a Gardeniser Pro training via three learning modules:

Module 1: How training can best be delivered.

Module 2: How to structure and design training session

Module 3: Going through the Gardeniser Pro course.

Key Information

Candidates should have:

- ! Proven training skills.
- ! A good knowledge of sustainable practices within a farm or garden.
- ! The ability to organise and plan effectively.
- ! A good understanding of group dynamics and the flexibility to adapt to group needs.
- ! Excellent written and communication skills including familiarity with online platforms such as Zoom. The course will be given in English.

While it would be ideal if applicants had a Gardeniser Pro licence already, we can arrange for otherwise qualified candidates to make up the Gardeniser Pro course at a later date.

The training is free of charge for participants. However, candidates would need to pay their own travel accommodation for a planned 3-day, in-presence training session in Belgium early in 2022 (depending on covid restrictions).
